Lt Col Bryan G. Becker is the Commander, 6th Space Warning Squadron, Cape Cod Space Force Station, Massachusetts, responsible for detecting sea-launched and intercontinental ballistic missiles and reporting to the nation's command and control centers for integrated tactical warning and attack assessment of missile attacks against the North American continent. 6 SWS also tracks satellites to provide space domain awareness to U.S. Space Command and other mission partners across the world. He is also responsible for the maintenance, support, defense and sustainment of Cape Cod Space Force Station.



Lt Col Becker entered the Air Force in 2008 as a graduate of the United States Air Force Academy. He has served as a space and missile operational crewmember, instructor, evaluator, flight commander, and assistant director of operations in the Space-Based Infrared System (SBIRS) Highly Elliptical Orbit (HEO) and Minuteman III Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM). He completed a staff tour at Air Force Space Command (AFSPC) and Space Operations Command (SPOC) serving as a chief programmer for Space Situational Awareness and Missile Warning Programs, as well as serving in the Commander's Action Group as a legislative liaison and Chief of Strategic Design. Prior to assuming his current position, he served as a USSF Exchange Officer and Student at the Canadian Force College, participating in the Joint Command and Staff Program. He then went on to serve as the Director of Operations for part 7 (Space) Wing of the Royal Canadian Air Force, based in Ottawa, Ontario. Lt Col Becker is a native of Moorhead, MN, and is married to Mrs. Lindsay Becker. They have two children Sutton (5) and Jaxon (2).
